A great way to meet our curious canines and playful pup personalties



A Clinic That Keeps On Going

est in show? Try Best of Central Florida! For the fourth year in a row, SPCA Florida Veterinary Clinic has been honored as the best veterinary clinic in Central Florida, and we couldn't be prouder! The clinic began in 2001 offering spay and neuter procedures and has grown into a full-service veterinary hub. We offer vaccines, preventative and wellness care, daily spay and neuter, soft tissue and specialty surgeries, and dental care. Our clinic hosts two Pitties & Kitties low cost, and no cost spay and neuter events every year, sterilizing 120 dogs and cats in one day. And in 2024, we reached a life altering milestone

of 12,641 spay and neuter surgeries. We work with outside hospitals when we can accommodate urgent medical requests and we partner with Polk County Animal Control, often providing medical care and surgery for their animals. While our clinic has come a long way, we recognize that there's always more room for growth. We're committed to continuing our mission to improve the lives of pets and the people who love them, making Central Florida a healthier, happier place for animals, both big and small. Our gratitude runs deep for the opportunity to care for our communities' pets and make a positive difference in their lives.


